MARITIME & COASTGUARD AGENCY (MCA) HEAVY DEPLOYMENT TRAINING EXERCISE

- Exercise Dates: Monday 13th September to Friday 17th September 2021
- Exercise Times: Daylight Hours
- Exercise Locations: Portland Port Controlled Area, as marked on BA Chart 2268
Portland Inner Harbour, between Outer Coaling Pier and Fort Head
Portland Outer Harbour, Balaclava Bay
TV Tristram and its Exclusion Zone
- Exercise Vessels: Ocean Osprey and several smaller supporting vessels

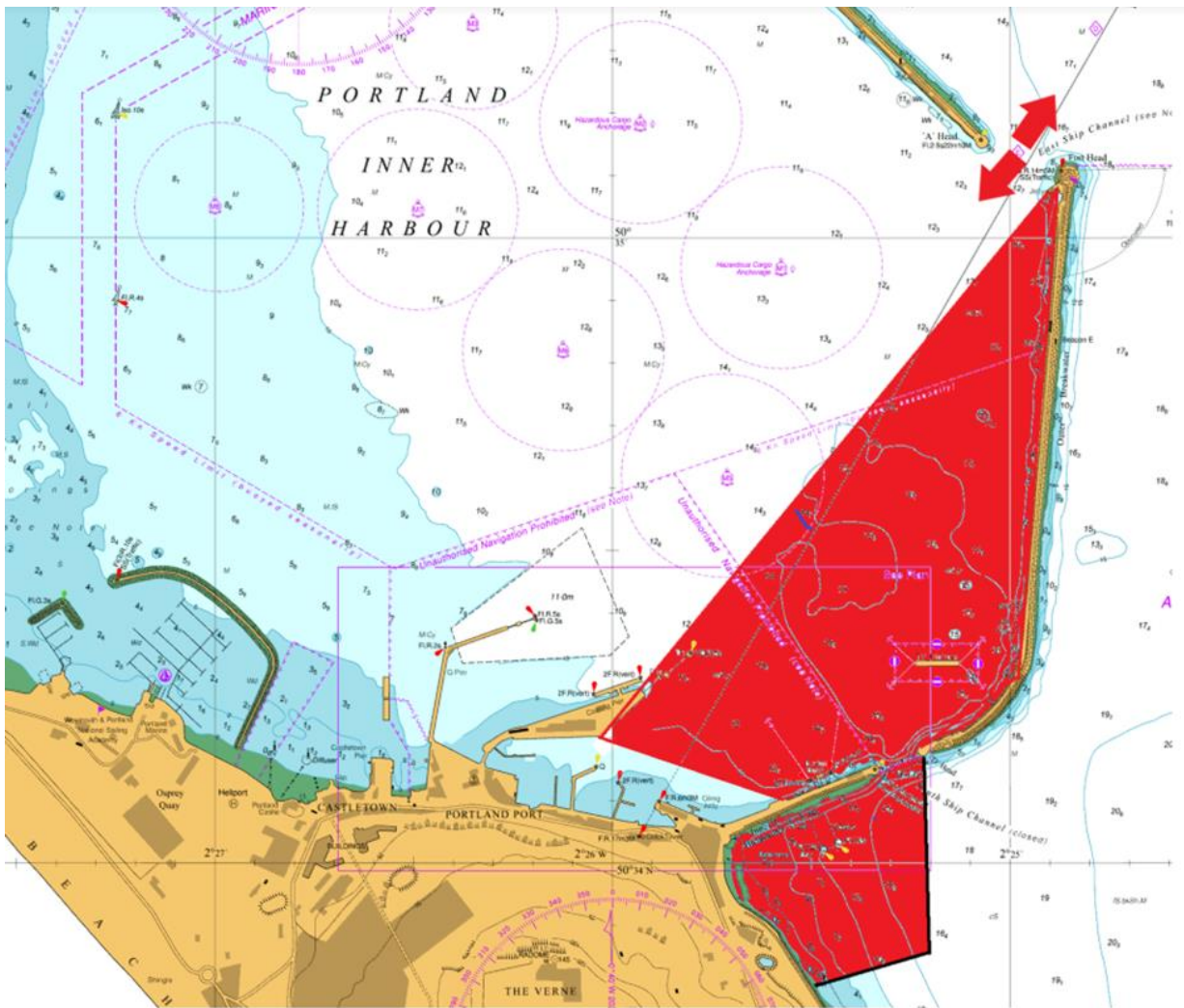
Mariners are advised of the above Counter Pollution Exercise which will be taking place between Monday 13th September and Friday 17th September 2021.

The exercise will be managed from a berth on the Inner breakwater (within the Controlled Area of Portland Port) This berth will be used for deploying various types of equipment including pollution booms to and from the exercise locations detailed above. A number of small vessels will be towing exercise equipment astern with a tow length of up to 200m – Safety vessels will be in attendance.

The Exclusion Zone around the TV Tristram should be observed at all times due to the presence of exercise equipment, which may remain overnight.

Mariners are advised to keep a good look out, proceed at a safe speed and give all vessels involved in this exercise a wide berth.
